ABOUT CELTA

The CELTA course provides practical, initial training in teaching English to speakers of other languages. The CELTA qualification is awarded by Cambridge English, a part of the University of Cambridge, and it is the most widely recognised English teaching qualification in the world; three out of four English language teaching jobs require a CELTA qualification. ILC France offer the course in three different modes of delivery: face to face, online, and a combination of face to face and online – the online blended CELTA.

The course covers the general principles of teaching adult classes at all levels, from beginners to post-intermediate: most students throughout the world fall into this category. The teaching methods and techniques covered by the course are those used in recognised English language schools all over the world.
