ABOUT CELTA

The CELTA course provides practical, initial training in teaching English to speakers of other languages. The CELTA qualification is awarded by Cambridge English, a part of the University of Cambridge, and it is the most widely recognised English teaching qualification in the world; three out of four English language teaching jobs require a CELTA qualification. ILC France offer the course as both part time and full time and in four different modes of delivery.

The course covers the general principles of teaching adult classes at all levels, from beginners to post-intermediate; most students throughout the world fall into this category. The teaching methods and techniques covered by the course are those used in recognised English language schools all over the world.
