




# CELTA

**Teacher Training at ILC France** 



The CELTA course provides practical, initial training in teaching English to speakers of other languages. The CELTA qualification is awarded by Cambridge English, part of the University of Cambridge, and is the most widely recognised English teaching qualification in the world – three out of four English language teaching jobs require a CELTA qualification. ILC France offers the course both part-time and full-time online. Successfully completing the course qualifies you to teach both online and in person.

The course covers the general principles of teaching adult learners at all levels, from beginners to post-intermediate – the level at which most learners around the world are studying. The methods and techniques taught on the course are those used in recognised English language schools worldwide.
